The **Defence Honours and Awards Appeals Tribunal** is an independent statutory body established under the *Defence Act 1903* to consider Defence honours and awards matters. The Tribunal provides an avenue for individuals to seek review of their eligibility for a defence honour or award after an application has been refused by Defence. The Government may also refer general eligibility issues relating to Defence honours and awards to the Tribunal for inquiry and recommendation. The Tribunal consists of a Chair and between six and ten members, all of whom serve in a part-time capacity. Several member vacancies will arise on the Tribunal over the next 18 months.

To be a strong contender for one of these important roles, you will need to have substantial experience in one or more of the following areas: Australian Defence Force command and leadership; administrative law and statutory interpretation; complex dispute resolution, or service on a government tribunal; or other relevant professional expertise.

You will also be expected have a sound knowledge of Australian military history and the ability to quickly develop a working knowledge of the Australian Defence honours and awards system. Your exceptional communication and representational skills will be complemented by a collaborative approach, high ethical and integrity standards, and a personal style that engenders trust and respect.

Members may be appointed for a period of up to three years, with the possibility of an extension to a maximum of six years in total. Remuneration and conditions of appointment are available with the selection documentation.
