I served with RCB from 03/06/1989 to 10/09/1989 with 5/7 RAR as a Lance Corporal attached to C Company 7 Platoon. Prior to departing for RCB Butterworth Malaysia we were instructed that there was a real enemy threat and as a result months of lead up training was conducted at company level including but not limited to: Live fire exercises, night operations, jungle warfare operations, QRF drills, gas training, and counter ambush drills. On arrival at RCB we were directed not to venture out of the barrack's especially in the vicinity of the RAFF base and surrounds because of recent occasions where local security forces had reported communist insurgent enemy operations and as a result were on high alert. We were told by our commanding officers that if we did not have clearance to leave the confides of the barrack's we may be shot at. I recall commencing guard duty and QRF duty very early in out tour at RCB where we had access to live ammunition and SOP's in place if we were required to activate the QRF in response to enemy attack on the base or air field at Butterworth Air Base. I recall a number of exercise's where our section commanders were issued and carried live rounds in case they needed to use deadly force to protect our section.
