Desired Outcome

Any recognition of such service by Army would have to take in/include the Air Force Ground Defence Section/Operations Room personnel. That Section (I served there between 1979 - 1981 for 30 months) had a personnel strength inclusive of Ground Defence Officers and Airfield Defence Guards only of 2xOfficers and 3x Airmen. Standard Posting tour was between 24 to 30 months. That Section OIC was the conduit to task the Army Company (on behalf of the Base Commander) for any required operational task, and was the liaison for day to day activity as well as controlling ammunition and weapons storage. That Defence Section went regularly to potentially hostile, or dangerous areas, in the contested areas of Malaysia and the Thai border to obtain intelligence and status reports from Malaysian Police Field Force Kulim and to the Southern Border of Thailand, to Betong, to obtain operational information from the Thai equivalent of the Malaysian Field Force. The Army Company personnel remained at Butterworth for their main role as a QRF/other tasks as directed (one platoon on call) and the remainder on training, either on Base, or with the Malaysian Army in their training area south of KL. The Company also practised it's role of providing additional Base Security during annual 5 Nation IADS Base Air Defence Exercises. The Defence Section conducted Army arrival and departure briefs, weapons control, ROE and incident tasking, including SAR, which may or may not include the Army Company and the RAAF Iroquois helicopters

Provide a summary of your submission.

The Ground Defence Section Butterworth Staff would need to be included in any medallic recognition to the Army Company by the Tribunal, as the Section faced greater potential danger than the Army Company and over a longer period than 3 months. And the Base Commander C&C was done via the Ground Defence Section/Operations Centre for all Base required Security tasking. The Section was an integral part and more for, and of, any/all security situations.

Further to the above attachment – An Air Force Ground Defence Officer (GRDEFO), out of the 2 on posted strength, was required to be on 24 hour call to respond to any security incident, or operational task, as well as one of the ADG airmen for support purposes (armoury access/briefing requirements, establishing the alternate/back up HF communications and other support as and if required. The Section personnel would also be armed (if needed/required) with own access to individual weapons/ammunition, and would respond, as required, to any adverse or hostile incident or situation including evacuation or protection of off base military personnel in MQ and other Australian civilian staff in support to Butterworth. The RAAF Ground Defence Force is the equivalent of Air Force Infantry in training and weapon skills and the Force Protection role. The Section also conducted weapon training and field skill training to other Base staff as required, and conducted the overarching area operational tasking to the Army Company Commander for the Butterworth Force Protection and Air Base Defence role and Base personnel protection on and off Base in conjunction with Malaysian Air Force Security, Malaysian Infantry/Police Field Force, Butterworth Rifle Company and RAAF Police.
