Our pre-deployment training included crowd and riot control featuring a British Military film showing the use of rifle fire to quell a riot. Prior to deployment we were required to learn the phase "Stop or I'll Shoot" to be spoken in Malay in a loud and clear voice three times. At our last briefing prior to deployment our OC stated that we were "Officially Warned out For Active Service". All of our training gave me the impression that we would be facing dangerous times during our deployment including armed attacks by the Communist Terrorists. During all call outs live ammunition was carried in one's webbing. Upon reaching the suspect area we were then ordered to load our personal weapon. During our return from the Malaysian Jungle Training center, I carried a loaded 9mm Browning Pistol.
