Mr Chairman,

Firstly I wish to thank you and the Tribunal for your efforts to date.

I am attempting to answer your question about expected casualties at RCB from a personal view.

It grieves me to use my fallen brothers who died on duty at Butterworth as a RCB rotation.

RCB have lost 13 soldiers over a time frame from 1971-1998 where the 5/7 RAR (Mech) bore the burden of most casualties 7 in number. To break it down further 4 members lost their lives during the Communist Insurgency period and the remainder after the conflict period.

I personally knew 6 of those members of the 5/7 RAR (Mech) who were some of the best soldiers I know. I would like to draw your attention to the fact that the 4 members of RCB that lost their lives during the Communist Insurgency period(1971-1989) these were fully manned rifle companies with medic's attached to every platoon with the company and a fully functional hospital on base with easy access to medical equipment, bandages, medication, bod bags and a morgue and of course the RAAF Search and Rescue aircraft, where in comparison with the 5/7 RAR (Mech) soldiers (RCB's only mass casualties) who died as a result of a truck accident in 1993 there is a distinct lack of medical equipment available, bandages, medication and body bags and morgue.

With the result of lack of emergency equipment available the injured and the deceased waited up to 12 hours to receive attention, this was mentioned in the defence investigation and Coroner inquest.

The memorial of our fallen at Butterworth Air Base was commissioned by defence and DVA and maintain by Australian Army 2/30 Training Group Butterworth Air Base.

So in conclusion, I believe RCB meets your requirements of expectations of casualties.
