As a RAAF radio aircraft technician for the Mirage fighter aircraft I was posted to two tours of duty at Air Base Butterworth from 1979 to 1982 and 1985 to 1987. I have noted that several RCB personnel in their submissions to this enquiry have stated that they were required to remain and sleep in the Base Armoury with live ammunition. I wish to point out that during my first tour of duty RAAF personnel, myself included, were also on a rotating roster, especially weekends, to sleep overnight inside the locked Armoury with live ammunition. We

were not permitted to leave the Armoury under any circumstances while on that duty. Our food was brought to us by the Service police.
